

Exhibit 44. Time grade 8 mathematics teachers reported having students do exercises or homework during class. U.S. teachers allow for far more homework in class than do the other two countries on average. All three countries make extensive use of "seatwork," (in-class exercises done by individuals but related to the current lesson). Japanese teachers report using such in-class exercises considerably more than do U.S. teachers. [This exhibit displays the average number of minutes of in-class time teachers report using for students to do exercises (as part of the current lesson) and "homework" (as follow-up to a completed lesson).]
